



Equine Assisted Learning & Service Activities Retreat for Veterans

Spend a weekend at Live and Let Live Farm engaging in equine assisted learning and service activities. This program is facilitated by a licensed clinical social worker who is a former Navy SEAL, along with a team skilled in working with veterans and the issues they face.

Participants will spend the weekend helping rescued horses reintegrate and heal from prior neglect and abuse, and assisting with farm upkeep. Service activities and working with rescue horses fosters resiliency leading to growth and well-being for both humans and horses. It is not a horseback-riding program; it is an experiential program designed to bring about change for humans and horses through practicing communication, leadership, authenticity and relational skills. Lunches and dinners will be provided at the farm in a cookout style.

Lodging, meals and activities provided at no cost to the participants but they must arrange their own transportation to/from Gilford, NH.
